Minutes of the Meeting of April 5, 2017

**I. Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at 6:04 p.m.

**II. Audience for Citizens**

No members of the public wished to speak during this portion of the meeting.

**III. Scope and Focus of Committee Study Items**

There was a general discussion about prior studies that had occurred and of the practical impact of declining school enrollment. Committee members discussed whether certain schools within the district might ultimately be closed as a result of declining enrollment. Mr. Venhorst emphasized that the Committee's role is to provide a report in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes § 10-63c and to make a recommendation as to whether the regional district as a whole should be dissolved.

Committee members generally agreed that the 2009 dissolution study was a useful blueprint for this committee to use but that a number of items need to be updated. The committee briefly reviewed various portions of the 2009 and discussed how updates might occur.
