

Later on Aunt Eleanor graduated from eighth grade on the stage there. I was ill and couldn't attend, but a friend of my aunt stayed with me. I can still hear the music coming over the air and wishing I were there. The men used to put on minstrals, and the townspeople enjoyed seeing their own people perform.

When I was older I, too, stood on the same stage and graduated from eighth grade. Later I had many enjoyable evenings there square dancing. I still remember going with a bunch of girls and wondering of anyone would ask me to dance. I always came home happy. Boyfriends later took me there to dance in my later years. I also attended town meetings and other functions there.

Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts held their meetings at the Grange, as well as members of the 4-H groups. Many happy occasions took place there, including once a Burdick family reunion. Happy memories!
