RULES GOVERNING THE REPUBLICAN PARTY OF THE TOWN OF CHAPLIN
(Dec. 1986)

RESOLVED: That the following be and they are hereby adopted as the rules governing the Republican Party of the Town of Chaplin.

TOWN COMMITTEE

Section 1. The Republican Town Committee of the Town of Chaplin shall consist of fifteen (15) members who are registered voters of the Republican Party in said town.

Section 2. Members of the Republican Town Committee shall serve a two (2) year term : Officers will be elected annually unless superseded by State law.

Section 3. Any vacancy which may arise in the membership of the Town Committee shall be filled by the Town Committee.

Section 4. Meetings of the Town Committee shall be held on the third (3rd) Wednesday of every month. The Chairman shall call a special meeting on written request of eight (8) members withing ten calendar days after receiving such request.

Section 5. Eight (8) members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business.

Section 6. Notice of all meetings shall be given each member at least five (5) days in advance of said meeting.

Section 7. The Town Committee shall be governed in all its actions by the majority rule.

RULES FOR CAUCUSES OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY IN THE TOWN OF CHAPLIN

RESOLVED: That the following be and they are hereby adopted as rules for Caucuses in the Republican Party in the Town of Chaplin.

Section 1. Notice is posted as to time, date and place.

Section 2. Caucus shall follow the current guidelines provided by the office of the Secretary of State of Connecticut.
