Chaplin Public Works Department is requesting proposals from contractors to provide asphalt paving and various replacement services for the Town of Chaplin. Said services will include the removal of the current surface, proper prep, and the installation of a new asphalt surface on the Town Hall parking lot.

I. PURPOSE AND GENERAL INFORMATION

It is the intent of this Request for Proposal to solicit bids for professional asphalt and replacement services for the Town of Chaplin, through its Public Works Department. Town of Chaplin is inviting proposals from State of Connecticut licensed Contractors to provide construction and reconstruction of the designated parking lot within the Town of Chaplin. The work scheduled to be performed from August 3rd – October 16th, 2020.

II. SCOPE OF SERVICES

A. Town Hall Parking Lot Replacement:

- Keyway milled at the apron of Route 198 as marked by Chaplin DPW.
- Rip out and remove all remaining asphalt as it exists in parking lot. (approximately 20,000 SQFT) Town CAN provide dumpsite of material if contractor desires.
- Grade base material and compact.
- DPW will provide up to 40 tons of processed aggregate if needed. (Contractor responsible for grading)
- Install the first binder course of Class 1 asphalt to a compacted depth of 2"
- Install top course of Class 2 asphalt to a compacted depth of 2"
- Final grade of asphalt shall be no more than 7" inches below the top of concrete sidewalk curb and shall be blended to the ADA sidewalk access ramp.
- Asphalt curbing to be replaced where removed.

III. RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT

The Town of Chaplin reserves the right to select the service provider which best meets the Town's goals and objectives, needs, budget constraints, and quality levels, as well as its service level expectations. The Town reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any/or all proposals, to waive any irregularities and technical defects contained therein, to award the contract in its entirety, in part or not at all and/or to determine which proposal is the lowest and/or best to enter into a Contract, as it may deem to be in the best interest of the Town of Chaplin.

IV. PREPARATION OF THE PROPOSAL

Proposals should provide a straightforward, concise description of the proponent's capabilities to satisfy the requirements of the RFBP. Emphasis should be on completeness, clarity of content, and conveyance of the information required by the Town of Chaplin. One (1) entire original proposal must be submitted by mail or appointment to the Chaplin First Selectman's office at Town Hall by July 21st, 2020 at 2:00 pm. The original must be marked as an original. At a minimum, the proposal should contain the following information:

- Business Organization State the full name, address, phone number, fax number and email address of your business and whether you operate as an individual, partnership, or corporation.
- List of business's experiences with federal, state or municipal programs pertaining to asphalt paving projects.
- Proof of appropriate state certifications Provide proof that you are licensed to operate in Connecticut.
- Qualifications Include a brief narrative description of the proposed services that will be delivered and the equipment available to perform the services. Please indicate completed projects of similar nature. Also indicate a contact person for each reference cited.

V. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS - CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE

The contractor shall furnish certificates of insurance in the following accounts:

- Comprehensive General Liability including premises/operations, contractual independent contractors, broad form property damage and personal injury. Limits of liability shall be combined bodily injury and property damage:
- Auto liability, including owned, non-owned and hired limits of liability shall be combined bodily injury and property damage: \$1,000,000. Each occurrence: \$1,000,000 Aggregate.
- Excess Liability Umbrella Form: \$1,000,000
- Workers' Compensation Insurance Limit of liability shall be the statutory limits. State whether the sole proprietor and/or partners have elected to be included.
- The contractor shall have a certificate issued showing the Town of Chaplin as an additional named insured for the duration of the contract.

- Certificates shall be filed with the town's agent before work is started and contain a thirty (30) day written notice of cancellation clause.
- All personnel on site shall follow ANSI and OSHA standards for personal protective equipment.
- Contractor shall be responsible for damages incurred to town or personal property within the work zone.

VI. AGREEMENT/EXCEPTIONS

Submission of a proposal indicates the Contractor agrees to the terms, conditions and other provisions contained in the RFBP, unless the Contractor clearly and specifically presents in its proposal any exceptions to the terms, conditions, and other provisions contained in the RFBP. Exceptions presented in a proposal are not to be considered incorporated into the contract between The Town of Chaplin and the selected Contractor unless and until The Town of Chaplin agrees to accept such exceptions. The selected Contractor must acknowledge and agree that the contract resulting from this RFBP includes the terms, conditions, and other provisions contained in the RFBP, the proposal selected (including any exceptions accepted by The Town of Chaplin) which is acceptable to The town of Chaplin and is not in conflict or contravention of the RFBP, and any other documents mutually agreed upon by The Town of Chaplin and selected Contractor. No oral statements or any person shall modify or otherwise change or affect the terms, conditions, or specifications stated in the RFBP or the resulting contract. A formal contract will be awarded after the selection of a contractor for the services identified in the scope of services by The Town of Chaplin. The contractor shall not assign the contract or any part thereof to any other person unless such assignment is first approved in writing by The Town of Chaplin, it being understood that the contract shall not be assignable unless the proposed assignee is acceptable to the municipality. The request for assignment must include evidence that the proposed assignee qualifies under all requirements of the contract and must be addressed as defined in the contract for services.

VII. PROPOSAL SUBMITTAL

One entire original proposal must be submitted to the Chaplin First Selectman's office as follows: Town of Chaplin 495 Phoenixville Rd. Chaplin CT 06235. All proposals must be received prior to July 21st, 2020 at 2:00 pm. Proposals may be mailed or dropped off by appointment at the Chaplin Town Hall. Proposals must be received in the First Selectman's Office by July 21st, 2020 2:00 pm for it to be considered in the RFBP review process.

VIII. EVALUATION OF PROPOSALS

Only proposals meeting minimum qualifications will be evaluated. Certification by the State of Connecticut is required. Personnel must be State of Connecticut licensed. The Town of Chaplin will evaluate proposals based on, but not limited to, the following criteria:

- Experience in asphalt road paving and rehabilitation
- Capability of contractor and/or personnel
- References
- Price the Town of Chaplin reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals, in part or in total, and to waive any irregularity in any proposal if it is deemed to be in the best interests of The Town of Chaplin. The Town of Chaplin reserves the right to reject

the proposal of any contractor who has previously failed to perform properly, or to complete on time, contracts of a similar nature, who is not in a position to perform the contract, or who has habitually and without just cause neglected the payment of bills or otherwise disregarded his/her obligations to subcontractors, suppliers, or employees. The Town of Chaplin reserves the right to make an award based solely on the proposals submitted or to negotiate further with one or more vendors. The contractor selected for the award will be chosen on the basis of greatest benefit to The Town of Chaplin, not necessarily on the basis of lowest price. All costs incurred in the preparation and presentation of the proposal shall be wholly absorbed by the contractor. All supporting documentation and manuals submitted with this proposal will become the property of The Town of Chaplin unless otherwise requested by the contractor at the time of submission.
