The electors and those authorized to vote at town meeting are hereby warned that an Annual Town Budget Meeting will be held on Monday, May 8, 2023 at 7:00 PM at the Chaplin Senior Center, 132 Chaplin Street, Chaplin, Connecticut, for the purpose of acting upon the following items:

- 1. To elect a moderator for said meeting.
- 2. To nominate and elect to the Regional Board of Education of Regional District #11 one member for a full term of three years to commence July 1, 2023.
- 3. Whereas the Town is applying for Local Capital Improvement Grant Funds: therefore, to resolve to approve the CIP plan for FY **2024-2028** (on file with the Town Clerk).
- 4. *To receive and approve the Annual Town Budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2023-June 30, 2024 in the amount of \$ 9,647,758.00 as submitted by the Board of Finance and to appropriate the funds required; (contingent on asterisk *).
- 5. To appropriate and transfer for fiscal year 2022-2023 an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 from the General Fund Unassigned Fund Balance to the CIP Fund for the following project(s):
 - a. Project #3305.4 Road Maintenance.
- To appropriate and transfer for fiscal year 2022-2023 an amount not to exceed
 \$415,000.00 from the CIP Fund Project #3315.7 England Road Bridge to the CIP Fund Project #3315.6 Bedlam Road Bridge.
- 7. Public hearing and possible action to:
 - A. Adopt a proposed "Chaplin Bicentennial Arboretum Commission Ordinance."
 - B. Move and relocate the Chaplin Museum building from 11 Chaplin Street to 132 Chaplin Street.
- 8. Discussion and possible non-binding action on a potential sidewalk project from the Chaplin Senior Center to Town Hall.
- 9. To adjourn the meeting after completion of the foregoing business.

*At their meeting held on April 25, 2023, the Board of Selectmen voted, pursuant to CGS § 7-7, that item #4 of the Call of the Annual Town Meeting be submitted to a referendum vote at an Adjourned Town Meeting to be held on Tuesday, May 16, 2023 at the Chaplin Firehouse, 106

Phoenixville Road (Rte. 198) in said Chaplin from 12:00 Noon to 8:00 P.M. The question on the ballot label at said referendum shall read as follows:

"Shall the Town of Chaplin appropriate the sum of \$9,647,758.00 for the General Government and local Education Expenditures for Fiscal Year July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 as recommended by the Board of Finance?"

Absentee ballots for the May 16, 2023 referendum shall be available as provided by law to persons applying to the office of the Town Clerk during its regular business hours. Copies of the proposed Annual Town Budget and the proposed Ordinance are available for inspection in the Office of the Town Clerk.
