- 4. Move that pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 10-233d(g), the Region 11 Board of Education adopt the expulsion decision of the Woodstock Academy Board of Education in its entirety and expel the student discussed in executive session from attendance at Parish Hill High School and from presence

on school grounds and school sponsored activities consistent with the provisions of the referenced expulsion decision.

Further, the Board directs the administration to offer the student an alternative educational opportunity pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 10-233d(d) for the period of this expulsion for any period of actual exclusion.

The Board also directs the administration, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 10-233d(f), to record this expulsion on the student's cumulative educational record, to be expunged from such record if the student graduates from high school.

The Student may apply for early readmission to return on the first day of school for the 2025-26 school year. The Superintendent shall make the decision regarding early return. If the Student returns early, the Student shall not engage in any behaviors that could result in suspension or expulsion from school. If the Student enmgages in such conduct, the Superintendent may reinstate any unserved period of expulsion or commence new disciplinary proceedings.

Finally, the Board authorizes Stacy Foster and Attorney Dan Murphy to communicate in writing the Board's decision and the reasons therefore, consistent with the Board's executive session discussion, to the student and his/her parent(s).
