Neil called the meeting to order at 9:34 am.

1. Audience for Citizens: None
2. Secretary's Report: A motion was made by Neil to approve the minutes of the December 2018 meeting. Carl seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.
3. Correspondence: Roxanne read a "thank you" card to the entire board.

A contract was set up for an exterminator to come to the Senior Center monthly. Carl made a motion that each of the 3 members of the Chaplin Town Crew be given a gift card, of Roxanne's choice, in the amount of \$30.00 as a show of appreciation for all the hard work they've done. Shirley seconded the motion, and all were in favor. The motion passed.

5. Building Review: The new well for the Senior Center and Library is dug and hooked up but currently cannot be used as drinking water because the State of CT has one more test to approve. This test will hopefully be approved by February 22nd.

There are now new floors in the kitchen and bathrooms. There was some extra money leftover in the CIP for each job and therefore the bathroom walls were repainted, and new skirting was put up in the kitchen.

Larry Tripoli cleaned the carpeting and waxed the floors over the holiday break. The vents will be cleaned soon.

6. 2019 Budget: A 2019-2020 budget request was submitted to the BOF. There is a \$700.00 increase in maintenance/supplies, \$25.00 increase for postage, \$20.00 increase for cable/internet, \$500.00 increase for heating fuel/propane and a \$5.00 increase for telephone. Total cost of budget being \$76,040.75. The total difference being an increase of \$1,250.00.
