1. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 7:01 pm

- 2. First Audience of Citizens: Jim Randall reported that the Annual RI-MA-CONN Bike race will be coming through Chaplin on 8/26/2023. J Randall also reported that the Covid 19 test kits that the town is now in possession of have expired. He is currently looking into disposal procedures and the cost of disposal. D Weingart asked Joe Pinto about the old fire truck's status since receiving the new fire truck. J Pinto reports that the old fire truck will be placed up for auction on the GovDeals website in the next week or two.

- C. <u>Board of Finance Discussion:</u> Chair of the Board of Finance, Dick Weingart, reported that the finance department has been busy with end of the fiscal year close outs and openings. The final approved budget for FY 2023-2024 has been sent to the State Office of Policy Management. All Pending and New FOI requests: J Roman reported that a new FOI request was received on 6/ from Elisabeth Ross, Ryan & Ryan, LLC for an electronic copy of the current collective bargaining agreement for the Town of Chaplin Resident State Trooper. An electronic copy of the Trooper Contract for FY 2023-2024 was sent to them on July 3, 2023. FOI closed.
- C. <u>Appointments and Resignations:</u> J Roman reported on the resignation of Ann Lewis from her position as the Municipal Agent to the Elderly effective July 1, 2023. Shirley Rakos has been appointed as her replacement.
