New Business: Mr. Peter Haines: 75 Palmer Rd. Pond shoreline grading

Mr. Haines discussed the revised the drawings to allow for the sump pond. He explained the layout of the area to be dug out after water is lowered and move the muck/dirt to Meadow A or Meadow B. The water pumped out will go into the sump pond.

P. Deveny recused himself due to his involvement with the work on this project. He explained about the sump pond and the swale located on the property. Mr. Haines explained that Meadow A (3-4 acres) or Meadow B (3-4 acres) if any water is pumped in either one it will sink in. P. Deveny recommends Meadow A due to the natural disbursement of the water. S. Matthies requested a diagram of the cross section of the pond bank showing existing slopes and how much is proposed to be dug out vertically. A site walk for commission members is scheduled for 10/31 at 10am.
