Conservation Commission Business:

S. Matthies sent out information on what the conservation commission does - inventory of natural resources in town. In the past they put together maps with the help of NECCOG showing wetland soils, farmland soils, land use, etc. There is protected space and state forest/open space located on South Bear Hill Road and Canada lane, the Helen Garrison trust. Currently there is no entity overseeing this parcel so it may be the Conservation Commission. At minimum, the boundaries should be marked. There is an encroachment already happening on the field that is being mowed, maybe mark with posts and medallions. S. Matthies found some pins and he may

have survey map. V. Walton will find out from Mansfield about the signs they use. J. Theroux suggested Voss signs and where to get them. S. Matthies suggested the commission come up with a management plan.

V. Walton reported that she is working on pollinator pathways with the Chaplin Economic and Development Commission. She is also working on the arboretum project pollinator plants and explained what pollinator pathways are. D. Field is also working on this for Joshua's Trust.
