Artist of the Month - Gail Miller

Nature's Bounty," the January art show features photographs, paintings, collage, and embroidery by Franklin artist, Gail Miller.

"Although I work in a variety of media, all my work focuses on the natural world, landscapes, flora, and fauna. I describe myself as 'always interested in nature' and enjoy skiing, kayaking and cycling in my leisure time.

Twenty-five years ago, I began capturing the outdoors that I love in photographs and oils. I paint rural landscapes and produce photographs of outdoor scenes as well as portraits of birds, amphibians, and a wide variety of plants and fungi. I feel that I have a natural eye for photography, and do not use Al. My photos have appeared in The Last Green Valley and the Franklin Agricultural Commission calendars.

A self taught artist, I have recently become more experimental, while still enjoying traditional media. About five years ago I began creating art using feathers, rabbit fur, leaves and other natural occurring material. The results include lively and richly colored images of birds and animals. I also do embroidery and crewel and enjoy a variety of other artful and useful fiber arts, including spinning yarn, knitting and crochet. This blend of the practical and the decorative runs through all my productions as does my love for the natural world. I collect beach stones and shells to make jewelry and art on canvas or whatever is suitable and made a patterned walkway using beach stones. I also use beads to make bracelets and necklaces.

Inspired by the natural world, I treat art and craft, photography, paints and fibers with equal pleasure and enthusiasm. I have exhibited my works at the Norwich Arts Center as well as several craft fairs.




