WARNING OF ANNUAL TOWN BUDGET MEETING
Monday, May 9, 2022

The electors and those authorized to vote at town meeting are hereby warned that an Annual Town Budget Meeting will be held on May 9, 2022 at 7:00 PM at the Chaplin Senior Center, 132 Chaplin Street, Chaplin, Connecticut, for the purpose of acting upon the following items:

1. To elect a moderator for said meeting.
2. To nominate and elect to the Regional Board of Education of Regional District #11 one member for a full term of three years to commence July 1, 2022.
3. Whereas the Town is applying for Local Capital Improvement Grant Funds: therefore, to resolve to approve the CIP plan for FY **2023-2027** (on file with the Town Clerk).
4. *To receive and approve the Annual Town Budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2022-June 30, 2023 in the amount of \$ **9,496,493** as submitted by the Board of Finance and to appropriate funds required; (contingent on asterisk *).
5. To appropriate and transfer for fiscal year 2021-2022 an amount not to exceed **\$650,000** from the General Fund Unassigned Fund Balance to the CIP Fund for the following project(s):
 - a. Project #3315.7 - England Road Bridge (**\$600,000**).
 - b. Other projects per CIP Plan (**\$50,000**)
6. To appropriate and transfer for fiscal year 2021-2022 an amount not to exceed **\$45,000** from the General Fund Reserved Account #10701.10 BOE Non-Lapsing Carryover to the CIP Fund for the following project(s):
 - a. New project - CES Smart Board Replacement.
7. Public hearing and possible action to:
 - A. Adopt a proposed "Ordinance Authorizing Appointment of an Alternate Member to the Library Board of Trustees of the Town of Chaplin."
 - B. Adopt a proposed "Snow Removal Ordinance."
8. To discuss and to vote whether to approve the sale of the previously discontinued Tutko Road to an abutting property owner for the price of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).
9. To adjourn the meeting after completion of the foregoing business.

*At their meeting held on April 26, 2022, the Board of Selectmen voted, pursuant to CGS § 7-7, that item #4 of the Call of the Annual Town Meeting be submitted to a referendum vote at an Adjourned Town Meeting to be held May 17, 2022 at the Chaplin Firehouse, 106 Phoenixville

Road (Rte. 198) in said Chaplin from 12:00 Noon to 8:00 P.M. The question on the ballot label at said referendum shall read as follows:

“Shall the Town of Chaplin appropriate the sum of \$9,496,493 for the General Government and local Education Expenditures for Fiscal Year July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 as recommended by the Board of Finance?”

Absentee ballots for the May 17, 2022 referendum shall be available as provided by law to persons applying to the office of the Town Clerk during its regular business hours. Copies of the proposed Annual Town Budget and the proposed Ordinances are available for inspection in the Office of the Town Clerk.
