BUDGET REFERENDUM
MAY 3, 2016

Notice is hereby given that a Referendum as required pursuant to Section 10-51 of the Connecticut General Statutes will be held on May 3, 2016 in the towns of Chaplin, Hampton & Scotland between the hours of 12:00 noon and 8:00 p.m.

The question will appear on the voting ballot labels as:

“Shall the sum of \$ 6,449,872 be appropriated for the operation and maintenance of the Regional District #11 Public School System for the July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 fiscal year?”

The vote will be by machine. Absentee ballots shall be available as provided by law through the office of each Town Clerk during its regular business hours.

For persons qualified to vote in the town of Chaplin, polls will be open from noon to 8 p.m. at the Chaplin Fire Department, 106 Phoenixville Road, Chaplin.

For persons qualified to vote in the Town of Hampton, polls will be open from noon to 8 p.m. at the Town Hall, 164 Main Street, Hampton.

For persons qualified to vote in the town of Scotland, polls will be open from noon to 8 p.m. at the Fire Safety Complex, 47 Brook Road, Scotland.
