## RULES GOVERNING THE REPUBLICAN PARTY OF THE TOWN OF CHAPLIN January 2022

RESOLVED: That the following be and they are hereby adopted as the rules governing the Republican Party of the Town of Chaplin

## TOWN COMMITTEE

- SECTION 1: The Republican Town Committee of the Town of Chaplin shall consist of Twenty-One (21) members who are registered voters of the Republican Party in said town. Revised January 6, 2022. Membership increased from fifteen (15) to twenty-one (21)
- SECTION 2: Members of the Republican Town Committee shall serve a two (2) year term.

  Officers will be elected annually unless superseded by State Law.
- SECTION 3: Any vacancy which may arise in the membership of the Town Committee shall be filled by the Town Committee.
- SECTION 4: Meetings of the Town Committee shall be held on the third (3rd) Wednesday of every month. The Chairman shall call a special meeting on written request of eight (8) members.
- SECTION 5: Eight (8) members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business.
- SECTION 6: Notice of all meetings shall be given each member at least five (5) days in advance of said meeting.
- SECTION 7: The Town Committee shall be governed in all its actions by majority rule.

## RULES FOR CAUCUSES OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY IN THE TOWN OF CHAPLIN

- RESOLVED: That the following be and they are hereby adopted as rules for Caucuses in the Republican Party in the Town of Chaplin.
- SECTION 1: Notice is posted as to time, date, and place.
- SECTION 2: Caucus shall follow the current guidelines provided by the Office of the Secretary of State of Connecticut.
